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Students shall normally select not fewer than 24 and not more than 30 credits of courses in any one semester (except the summer semester). Taking 60 credits per academic year is considered to be normal load. Students may take additional credits not exceeding 6 credits in each semester, and/or further credits during the summer semester, accumulating up to a maximum of 72 credits in one academic year.

Curriculum Requirement

To complete the degree requirement, a student must enrol courses of this programme totaling to at least 240 credits. In addition, students must pass the English and Chinese language courses, and six courses from the Common Core Curriculum, selecting at least one but no more than two courses from each Area of Inquiry, as well as satisfying other requirements as stipulated in the University or Faculty of Engineering regulations.

Courses

Please enrol the following courses:

- (a) 36 credits of Introductory Core courses
- (b) 6 credits of Advanced Core course
- (c) at least 18 credits of University Common Core courses
- (d) 6 to 12 credits of free electives (you may take in other study years)

Note: students are advised to enrol the CC courses **ASAP** due to keen competition of enrolment)

* Students are advised to take MECH2407 and MEDE2810 in two separate semesters for a balance of credits.

Untaken/Re-taken Courses

Students must enrol Level I courses that you have not yet taken or are required to re-take. Credits of such courses will be counted towards the total load.

Time Clash

Students will not be allowed to take courses with time clash. Hence, if you have to re-take a course which clashes with a higher level course, you should drop the higher level course.

On-line Course Enrolment

The course information system will be open for students to preview the available courses from **August 1, 2017 (Tuesday)**. Students should complete course enrolment online via the SIS during the course selection period and add/drop periods, and **NO change** of enrolment will be allowed after add/drop periods.

Course selection in August

Course selection period: August 9 (2 pm) – August 15 (4 pm), 2017

Suspension period: August 10, 2017 (9 am – 2:30 pm)

First semester of 2017-18

Add/Drop period: August 31 (12 pm) to September 13 (4 pm), 2017

Suspension period: September 1, 2017 (12 nn – 5 pm).

Please make sure your selected courses are approved by September 19, 2017 (11:59pm).

Second semester of 2017-18

Add/Drop period: January 15 (12 pm) to January 29 (4 pm), 2018

Suspension period: January 16, 2018 (12 nn – 5 pm)

Please make sure your selected courses are approved by February 2, 2018 (11:59 pm).

Summer semester of 2017-18

Add/Drop period: June 11 (10 am) to June 19 (4 pm), 2018

Suspension period: June 12, 2018 (12 nn – 5 pm)

Please make sure your selected courses are approved by June 23, 2018 (11:59 pm).

It is your responsibility to select the correct course codes and course titles. Any discrepancies will lead to your not being able to sit the right examination or not fulfilling the graduation requirement.
